CONTEXT

A position is available for a senior lecturer who has completed a PhD in biblical studies or a cognate discipline and is able to commence employment from 1 January 2023. The successful candidate will share the college's ecclesiastical and theological standpoints, as well as be able to demonstrate a passion for applying their learning within the African context.

THE COLLEGE

GWC is an evangelical theological college based in Muizenberg, a suburb on the False Bay coast of Cape Town. GWC equips men and women for Christian ministry in Africa and grants qualifications in Word ministry at HCTh, BTh, BTh (Hons) and MTh level.

GWC is the official training institution for the Reformed Evangelical Anglican Church of South Africa (REACH SA).

THE POSITION

A senior lecturer at GWC becomes part of the college community and, whilst occupied primarily as a teacher, is also involved in research and publishing, academic administration and student pastoral care. In addition, the senior lecturer occupying this position will co-ordinate a new programme being developed at the college.
