

- 1st** Students have completed their last week of lectures and are preparing for exams which begin 8 June. Pray that they would work consistently, remember what they have learnt, and be shaped as Christian men and women who can serve Christ's church faithfully.
- 2nd** Faculty are concluding their assessments of first-semester courses. Pray that their marking would be accurate and that feedback would be clear and edifying for students' growth in godliness.
- 3rd** An Online TALHITE Phase 1 course is being run from 1 - 5 June, with faculty members attending from Christian universities in South Sudan and Malawi. Pray for energy and wisdom for Drs Richard and Caroline Seed and Karen Roe as they facilitate the course, and that those attending will be able to apply what they learn in their teaching.
- 4th** Applications are being received for studies in 2027. Pray that the right students would be encouraged to apply, and that the Open Day sessions organised by the Registry team would go smoothly. Pray in particular for the upcoming online Open Day on 5 June.
- 5th** GWC past student, Christiaan Snell, Minister in charge of the Edgeworthstown Group and Ardagh Union of Parishes in Ireland has come to Cape Town for June, July and August as Sabbatical, with his family joining for some of the time. Pray for it to be a good time of refreshment here in South Africa.

Fahim, Chair of the New Testament Department at the Alexandria School of Theology, Egypt, is teaching a postgraduate intensive module from 10-19 June entitled *Justification, Good Works and Sanctification in Romans*. Pray for wisdom for Dr Fahim as he teaches, and for students to benefit richly from this course.
- 10th** GWC past student, George Robinson, pastor of Anchor Bible Church in Ballito, KZN, requests prayer as they seek to partner with like-minded churches and pastors to grow the church planting initiative and to form healthy local churches across denominations.
- 11th** Thank God for the successful completion of all eight Explore modules by the students at Jecom Centre, in Malawi. Praise the Lord for His faithfulness and pray for continued spiritual growth and fruitful service among these graduates.
- 12th** The Lovell family return to GWC after being on home assignment in Australia for the first six months of the year. Pray that they will feel refreshed and excited to resume their responsibilities as Director of Research (Nathan) and Dean of Women Students (Diane).
- 13th** TEDS will be providing training to GWC faculty members in mid-June. Pray that this would be a fun and beneficial time spent together and that it will result in greater support for students.
- 14th** Pray that students would finish their exams well and have restful holidays. Pray for safe travels for those who are leaving Cape Town to visit family.
- 15th** Pray for the Hosannah Church Explore group of 17 students in Hazeyview, Mpumalanga, currently studying Module 1. Pray that the students would remain encouraged, faithful, and committed to their studies as they grow in God's Word.
- 16th** Dr Richard Seed is presenting at TEASA Consultation 2026 which will be held 17-19 June in Kempton Park, Gauteng. Pray for both his preparation and delivery of his talk, and for travel mercies and strength.

- 26th** Pray for a spirit of unity to abound within our diverse student body, for there to be no opportunity for division to creep in, and for strong bonds of trust and friendship to form.
- 27th** GWC past student Elias Bonga is now a research student at the Eastern College Australia and his research title is *Examining the role of Juba Diocese in Peace building among the Bari Community*. He requests prayer as he begins this project and continues his research, also while continuing to lecture at Bishop Gwynne College.
- 28th** Campus Manager Clive Alfino officially retires from his role at the end of June. Praise God for his faithful service to the College over the past nine years, and pray that the Lord would be with him in his next chapter ahead.
